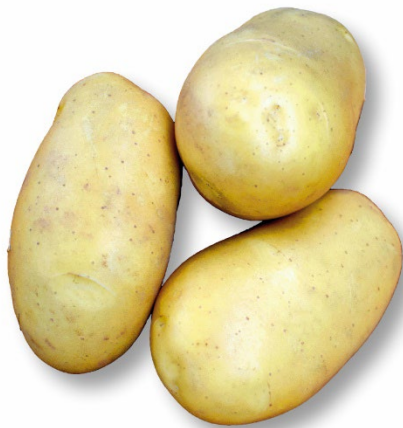




Medium early

DOUNIA is a medium early variety, productive, giving oval to long-oval shaped tubers with white flesh. Low susceptible to common scab, it has a good storage ability, dry matter content is about 21%, well suited for homemade French-fries.
