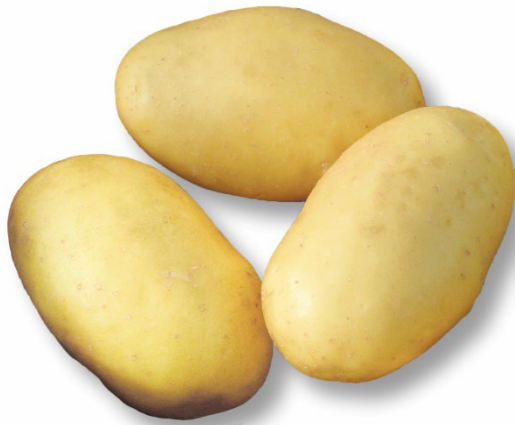




Mid-early

Lilia is a medium early variety with good tuber numbers and a yellow skin finish. Suitable for the fresh market and very good for homemade French fries. Good tasting quality and having a dry matter level of 21 %. Good for storage. It is resistant to nematode *globobera rostochiensis*.
