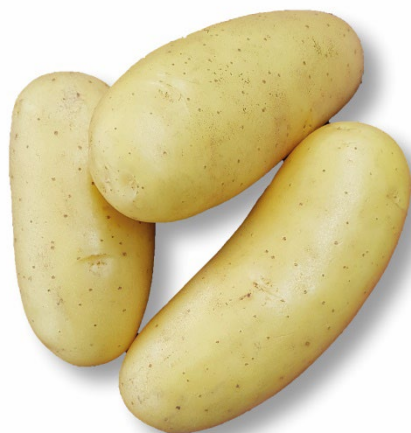

Maldive is an early variety, firm flesh, giving long oblong tubers with a bright yellow skin finish. It has a yellow flesh with very good tasting quality. Its dormancy period is short. Productive variety that adapts well to early productive areas, with resistance to nematode ro1-4 and virus Yntn.
